 As displayed above you can change the page header for specific pages and you can also do the same with page footers.

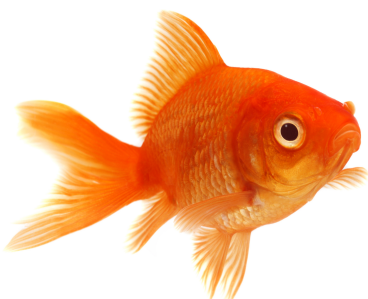
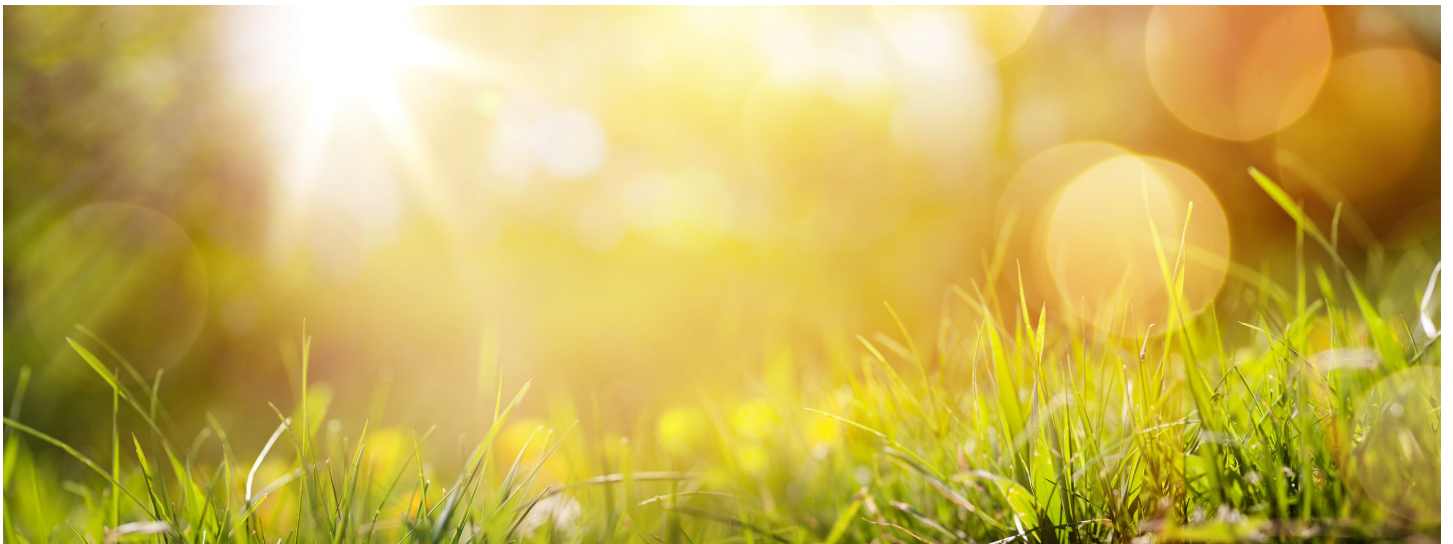
Static Images

Some questions within the form might be reliant on whether the respondent ever saw the subject you're talking about. For instance on the question "Have you seen the leaning tower of Pisa?" many people will instantly recall the famous tower, but some respondents might have trouble connecting the name to a particular visual experience.
